Turning Points in Global History – Research Project

Historians ask these questions when exploring events in history.

1. Use as many resources as necessary (Textbook, Regents Review Book, Internet, Classroom Wiki, etc.)
2. You will use one (1) chart for each event. You may use additional lined paper as needed. Indicate what category you are detailing if using lined paper. Ex. Who, What, Where, When, Why, Result.

The following is a description of the pieces of your chart.

Who – Who were the main participants (people) in the event? - Define the specific people (ex. Martin Luther, John Calvin)

Where – Where did the event take place? (may be more than one place) - (Ex. Italy in Europe, All of Europe, France)

When – When did the event take place? (maybe more than one date or year or between two dates/centuries ex. 18th cent.)

What – What happened and what was it? (explain in detail)

Why – Why did this event happen? Causes?

Result – What were the Results or Outcome of the event?

Vocabulary - Five (5) Vocabulary Words and how each word is connected to the Turning Point is required.

Ex. Humanism - The belief in the individual and worldly things over the Church and God, during the Renaissance. This allowed for people to question the authority of the Roman Catholic Church.

Why was this event a Turning Point - Explain in detail, why the event is considered a Turning Point?
