



### Student Sign Up Instructions

All students for Constitutional Law are required to sign up for two accounts to use throughout the school year. They are free sign ups and assignments, quizzes, and exams will be posted and completed online throughout the year.

#### Part 1: (Worth 50pts)

**Step #1:** Click the link or enter [www.courseworksplus.com](http://www.courseworksplus.com) on the address bar.

**Step #2:** Follow the steps below for Enrollment. The Enrollment key is: *constitutional*

**Is this your first time here?**

Hi! For full access to courses you'll need to take a minute to create a new account for yourself on this web site. Each of the individual courses may also have a one-time "enrolment key", which you won't need until later. Here are the steps:

1. Fill out the [New Account](#) form with your details.
2. An email will be immediately sent to your email address.
3. Read your email, and click on the web link it contains.
4. Your account will be confirmed and you will be logged in.
5. Now, select the course you want to participate in.
6. If you are prompted for an "enrolment key" - use the one that your teacher has given you. This will "enrol" you in the course.
7. You can now access the full course. From now on you will only need to enter your personal username and password (in the form on this page) to log in and access any course you have enrolled in.

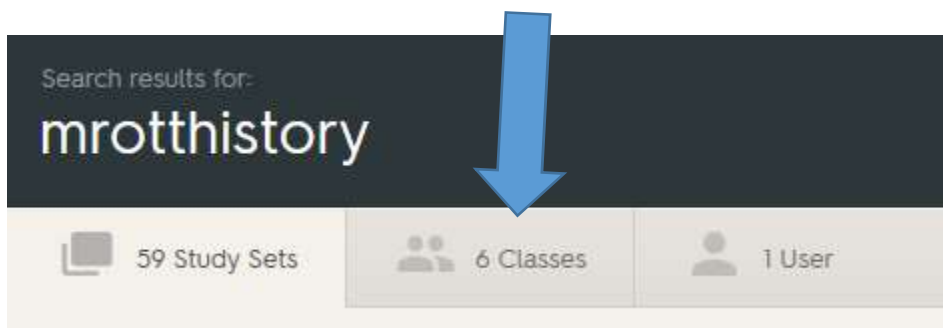
#### Part II: (Worth 50pts)

**Step #1:** Click the link or enter [www.quizlet.com](http://www.quizlet.com) on the address bar.


**Step #2:** Create an account or if you have an account skip to Step #3
